Creating a Strategic Plan For the South Harrison Township School District

Session 1 Defining the Strengths/Achievements and Challenges Of the South Harrison Township School District

On January 10,2019, South Harrison Township School District administrators, board of education members, education staff, parents and community members, twenty-three (23) in all, came together to initiate the strategic planning process for the school district. The first evening's topic focused on the strengths, achievements, and challenges facing the South Harrison Township School District. The meeting began with a welcome and introduction by the District Superintendent, Dr. James Lavender. Dr. Lavender presented the current "State of the District" outlining some foundational information about the school district. School Principal, Dr. Corinne Sannino, provided some student achievement highlights and additional district specific information. Facilitators Jesse Adams Jr. and Terri Lewis, from New Jersey School Boards Association (NJSBA), were introduced and Mrs. Lewis outlined the strategic planning process.

After the review of the consensus process utilized in strategic planning, participants were placed in three randomly assigned small groups ensuring a cross-section of stakeholders. The groups brainstormed the strengths/achievements and challenges of the district. After small group discussion, each group identified through consensus the "Top 10" strengths/achievements and "Top Ten" challenges of the South Harrison Township School District and presented those to the full group of meeting participants.

As discussed with the meeting participants, all group consensus points are recorded and available to share during the course of the strategic planning process. The following is a summary of the work of the small groups.
